Christmas Fair

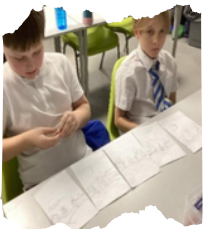
What a fantastic afternoon we all had celebrating Christmas in our school, fair. We are pleased to announce we made a huge profit of **£846.96**.

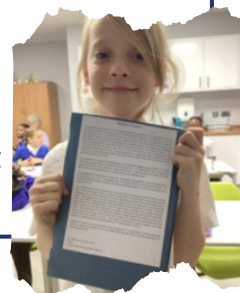
