Class of the week - Year 3: Explorers



This week in English, we began our new book *Our Tower* and explored onomatopoeic words, enjoying how they bring sounds to life in our writing. In Maths, we started our multiplication and division unit, using practical equipment to build arrays before applying our learning in our books.

In RE, we continued to deepen our understanding of the Holy Trinity and Baptism, discussing their significance and meaning. Our Art lesson has been trying out a range of sketching techniques and then challenging ourselves to include them all in a drawing.
